It is becoming increasingly evident that humans are having a negative impact on the earth's environment. We need to do a better job of reducing environmental damage and one way is to better protect the world's wilderness areas.

As the human population continues to grow, more and more wilderness land is being destroyed. This habitat destruction is one of the reasons many species like the panda bear are endangered. Also, plants and trees absorb CO₂, and emit oxygen. Any wilderness destruction means more CO₂ in the atmosphere, and thus more global warming. Damaging the environment and reducing the planet's biodiversity could have terrible consequences for humans.

Protecting wilderness areas is good for the environment. A good deal of international cooperation will be necessary to improve the situation. We have to help the poorest people who might be tempted to clear-cut forests for farming or to hunt endangered species for food or money. One strategy that seems to have some success is to show local people how they can benefit from ecotourism — which of course depends on maintaining wilderness areas.

Humans have already done terrible damage to the environment. We need to do much more to protect the world's wilderness areas.
